Water Facilities Gets OK

Authorization was granted Monday night by the Farmington Township Board to begin the work to provide water facilities to the northwestern section of Farmington Township. When the water lines in this area are laid, the entire township will be serviced by the Detroit water system. Actual work on the project is not expected to begin for about two years.

MONDAY NIGHT'S action merely authorizes the Oakland County Department of Public Works to develop the preliminary engineering plans, cost estimates and the financing schedules.

Cost of this work will not have to be paid until a special assessment district is created and the revenue bonds sold. The district is bounded by 14 Mile Rd. on the north, Haggerty Rd. on the west, a point just south of 11 Mile Rd. on the south, and a point just east of Drake Rd. on the east.

IN OTHER ACTION the Board: Approved some zoning changes, the most significant of which provides the township to regulate the height of roadside signs and other structures such as radio towers.

Adopted by reference a heating code ordinance which is currently in use in the metropolitan Detroit area.

Approved another ordinance establishing a special purpose district to cover the construction of hospitals, nursing homes and clubs or lodges.

Approved another ordinance establishing a new classification of a general business district which would allow for indoor retail businesses and veterinary hospitals and funeral homes.

Approved the rezoning of approximately five acres on Eight Mile Rd., just east of Pearl St. for the construction of apartments.

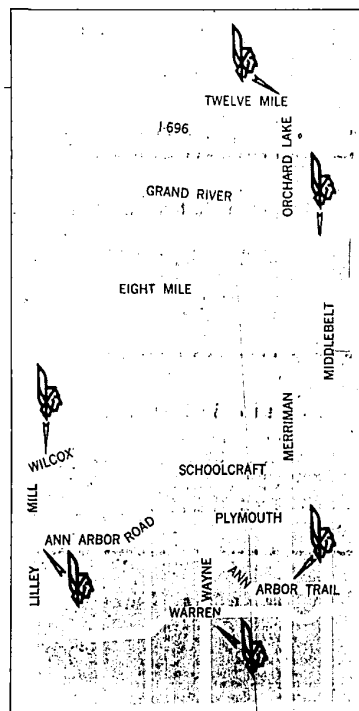
