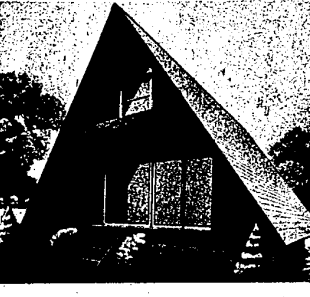

# New Draft Regulations Hit By Education Chief

MORE THAN 50 per cent of Florida's teachers resigned Monday in a bid for higher pay and more money for education. Some of the state's 67 county school systems planned to try operating with substitutes, supervisory personnel and teachers who have not resigned. Others have had to shut down completely. As the crisis came to a head, Gov. Claude Kirk begged teachers not to "desert your children."

PRESIDENT Lyndon Johnson announced that under new Selective Service regulations only graduate students in medical or dental schools or those in at least their second year of higher schooling will be granted deferments. In response to Johnson's announcement, President Logan Wilson of the American Council in Education urged "the administration and Congress to consider a system of random selection at the earliest possible moment" to spread the impact of the decision over all ages and classifications of draft eligibles.

ALEXANDER TROWBRIDGE was the third presidential cabinet official to announce his resignation. When he steps down as Commerce Secretary, he will leave President Johnson with three new faces on his top level advisory staff for the election year.

WILLIAM COLEMAN, 36, has been arrested on a 12-count first-degree murder charge after being accused of intentionally setting a fire that killed 12 people.

led 12 Moberly, Mo. tavern patrons. Fire Chief Leroy Willis said Coleman did it "as a grudge" because he was barred from patronizing the tavern.

AUTOMOBILE insurance on a payroll deduction plan may be coming to Ohio. Continental National American Insurance group of Chicago has submitted the plan to the Ohio State Department of Insurance. The state agency has challenged the plan and will have public hearings where the company is expected to furnish an explanation of finer details March 4 and 5.

THE AMERICAN Bar Association's top-drawer Board of Governors recommended the adoption of new guidelines limiting what the public may know about pending criminal cases. The controversial restrictions—which would be imposed on police, judges, and lawyers as well as reporters and editors—will go before the ABA's House of Delegates.

VICE-PRESIDENT Hubert H. Humphrey, urging draft-law revisions, said, "It's the non-student that really gets hooked in this one and really gets

hooked up." The man who is not in school, Humphrey declared, is "the one who really has the problem," for students, knowing their rights under the law, "have really less of a complaint about Selective Service than most other people."

SEN. EVERETT McKinley Dirksen (R-IL) announced he will seek a fourth term—saying he did not want to leave his spot in a crisis that is "more serious than we think."

PRESIDENT Johnson has named Frank Pace Jr., former secretary of the army and former director of the budget bureau, to be chairman of the new Public Broadcasting Corp. The Public Broadcasting Corp. was set by the Legislature last Nov. 7 to provide financial assistance for noncommercial educational television and radio broadcasting.

A COLLECTION of 87 documents from the Revolutionary War period, including 51 identification letters written by George Washington, has been discovered in a Vermont home and entrusted to the library of Union College in Schenectady, N.Y. The college said the collection contains a host of documents signed by prominent figures of the period including John Adams, Benedict Arnold, Alexander Hamilton, John Jay, Benjamin Franklin, George Clinton, Nathaniel Greene, John Hancock, Thaddeus Kosciuszko, Charles Lee, Israel Putnam, Edmund Randolph and Philip Schuyler.

THE NATIONAL Safety Council announced that fatalities from firearms and poisonings in homes increased in 1967 in spite of the lowest yearly home-accident death rate per 100,000 persons dropped from 15.1 in 1966 to 14.4 in 1967—an all time low. Home firearm accident deaths reached 1,600 last year—an increase of 7 per cent over the 1,500 fatalities in 1966.
