

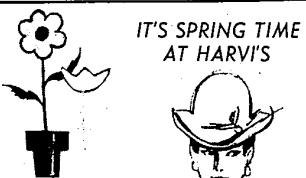
Art Work On Display

Works in the present display are by Mrs. R.V. Yasenchak and Mrs. S.G. Grabowski. They include abstracts, still lifes and landscapes.

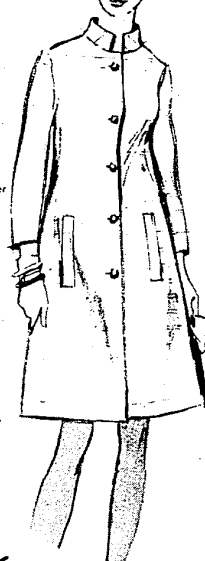
Farmington Librarian Mildred Droegge calls this effort by the Artists Club, "Another example of the good community spirit of Farmington residents."

Lone Thief Nets \$556 In Holdup

A lone pistol packing bandit staged a holdup of the Farmington Partyville Store, 29470 Ten Mile Rd. near Middle Belt, Sunday night, Feb. 25, and escaped with approximately \$556, according to Farmington Township police.

Moun Halder, proprietor of the party store, said he was alone at the time of the holdup at 10:45 p.m. when an apparent customer entered and pulled an automatic pistol, demanding Halder turn over all his funds.

Halder offered no resistance and the man fled after taking the money. He is being sought to face charges of armed robbery.

Farmington Agent Wins Two Awards

William F. Elders, of 22579 Gill Road, Farmington, an insurance representative, has earned two of his company's top production club honors. Figures released this week by General Agent Robert A. Reason reveal that in 1967 Elders issued over \$750,000 of new insurance protection to more than 100 clients in this area.

With membership in the 750 Club, Elders joins an exclusive group of representatives. Only 42 others, among more than 500 associates throughout the country, reached the \$750,000 mark last year.

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City Crime Increases In January

Chief Robert Deadman of the City of Farmington police department disclosed statistics this week showing the municipality had 40 "Class 1" crimes in January against only 22 during the same month of 1967.

Included were one armed robbery, nine forcible entry burglaries, 29 larcenies and one automobile theft.

The larceny figure compared with only 14 reported in January of last year. Burglaries were up, 9 to 7, in the other major increase.

There were six adult arrests in January, 1968, against only one a year ago. In juvenile cases, 13 January arrests were reported against 22 last January.

Thirty-five traffic accidents occurred in Farmington during the month, a decrease of four from 1967. Of the 35, seven resulted in injuries to a total of nine persons. No fatalities were reported in Deadman's synopsis of the month's activities.

During the month, police personnel also participated in 17 training sessions and extra meetings.



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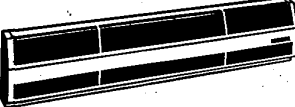
