THE FORMAT of play in the state tourney follows the same pattern as in years past.
Teams start out in 112 district meets from one end of the state to the other.
District winners then advance to 24 regionals, which will decide the eight quarterfinalists in each class.
From there it's on to East Lansing-Lansing, where the grand finales take place on Saturday, March 23, with all four finals in Michigan State's Jensen Field House.

Locally, the luck of the draw worked "beautifully" at the Franklin A district, where Garden City East and Bentley, both ranked among the top 20 in the state, fell in opposite halves of the draw.
Thus, it's possible for East, winner of the Mid-Wayne League title, and Bentley, champs in the Suburban Six-Loop, to collide next Friday night in the "perfect" finale at Franklin.


GARDEN CITY EAST has drawn Franklin as its first foe Monday night at 7:30 p.m. with the winner to play Stevenson Wednesday at 7:30. Meantime, Bentley goes against Garden City West Tuesday at 8:30, with the victor advancing to the Friday final.
Neither Franklin nor Stevenson would appear to be in East's class. West should offer Bentley a strong test, but isn't expected to pull off an upset.
The draw at North Farmington High precludes a final between Thurston and North Farmington, which appear to have the best two teams in the six-team field.
North Farmington starts against Plymouth Monday at 7 with the winner playing Thurston Wednesday at 7.

Schoolcraft College's swimming team wound up sixth in the State Community College meet last weekend.
The team did worst to Henry Ford with 153 points. Grand Rapids scored 67, Kellogg 65, Flint 34, Jackson 28 and Schoolcraft 25.
Dane Trembath led Schoolcraft scoring by placing second both in the 100 and 200-yard breast stroke events. The Schoolcraft medley relay team placed fourth.
