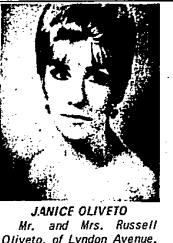




SANDRA KRZYZANIAK

You take a group of objects which were the earliest attempts to make the housewife's work easier. Then you add the exhibition talents of seven design students at Cranbrook Academy of Art. Result: The nostalgic yet whimsical new exhibition, "Mechanization Hits the Household," which opens in the Art Academy's Galleries on March 16 and will remain up through April 7.

The early mechanized items were loaned for this exhibit by the Henry Ford Museum. The Galleries of Cranbrook Academy of Art, located in Bloomfield Hills, are open from 1 to 5 p.m., Tuesdays through Sundays.

This exhibit presents the first mechanical aids to such jobs as washing and ironing clothes, house cleaning and meal preparation. It was also during this time that mechanical devices for home entertainment were being popularized.
