UP' GOING 'CURTAIN'

The evil nature of man was stressed in two theatrical attractions this past week. "Andorra" at the Bonstelle, showed how an entire village could smash a man's identity, grind him into oblivion. "Little Foxes" at the Fisher Theater was an excoriating revelation of the internal hatred that dominates many family groups. Such a plethora of malevolence could make a person think dire, pessimistic thoughts, especially when one considers the lack of newspapers, the Vietnam stalemate, and the call for more troops. A look at the calendar indicates that income tax time is just around the corner if one needs any further cheering up.

WHAT PURPOSE DO such serious plays serve? A production such as "Andorra" makes us realize that mob action and the rumors that accompany such affairs are as

dangerous and as lethal as weapons that kill physically. In "Andorra" the entire village is out to get a lonely Jewish youth. His father tries to protect him, but the forces of the majority over-rule him and he is eventually killed. Money Lewis turns in a diamond-sharp performance as the persecuted lad. His moments of anguish were rare sequences of genuine sensitivity. Director Russ Smith can add "Andorra" to his list of successful productions. He designed the setting that filled the huge Bonstelle Stage to over-flowing. The square in Andorra was reproduced so authentically you could inhale the draughts of the mountain air. "Andorra" having a multiplicity of scenes calls upon the imagination of the scene designer. Director Smith, though, "Little Foxes" as he always does so ably, provided his actors with a setting that reinforced their superb thespic endeavors. Every member of the cast turned in a strong performance. "Andorra" is the type of play that needs such mature acting. The whole impact of the play turns on the vicious narrowness of the townspeople. They hate the Jew boy. The final scene after they discover his innocence leaves you slightly stunned. You wonder as you leave the theater if there aren't instances where this has happened before in other localities. AT THE FISHER Theater Lillian Hellman's Pulitzer Prize play "Little Foxes" requires an actress of Talulah Bankhead's ability to play the lead role of Regina. Regina is the deadly female of the species that would devour everything and anything that gets in her way to accomplish her machiavellian machinations. Her ruthless attempts to acquire power and money from her many-hungry brothers is the main theme for the evening. Geraldine Page has been given the Bankhead role. Miss Page does not possess the throaty baritone that Miss Bankhead was famous for. Her thin, reedy voice has a high whine and irritates after awhile. Miss Page feels that she must be evil, facially and vocally.
