### It's Roaring 20's At Rosedale

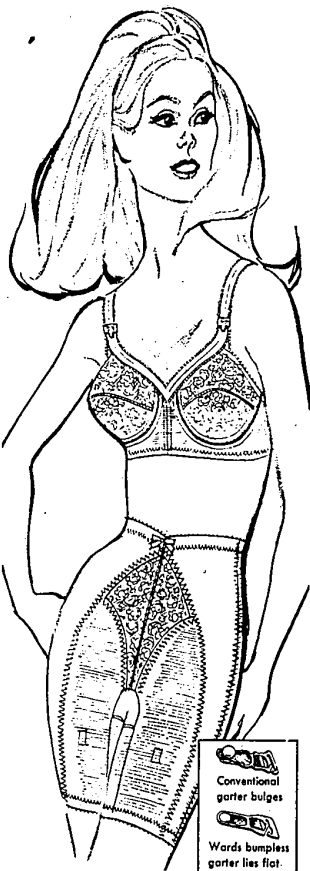

## 'Overture To Opera VII' Still Offered HS Students

The program "Overture to Opera VII," a sampling of the wares to be offered by the Metropolitan Opera when it visits Detroit in May, still is available to high school students in this area.

"Overture" featuring three operatic segments, will be presented in Southfield High School at 10 a.m. Tuesday, April 9, and a spokesman for the Women's Committee of the Detroit Grand Opera Association said bus transportation would be available.

Mrs. Lee Landes, of Livonia, added that recordings of the program and film strips and explanatory material also are available through March and April to schools and teachers in the area.

VOLUNTEERS WHO will present the music in schools have been trained by Dr. David DiChiera, acting head of the music department at Oakland University and producer-director of the Overture programs.

"Overture" is jointly sponsored by the Detroit Grand Opera Association, Oakland University and the University Center for Adult Education. Its purpose is to acquaint young people with opera, to give local artists an opportunity to appear in a professional production, and to present operas that would not otherwise be produced in this area.

Menotti's "The Medium" is the highlight of this year's presentations by Overture to Opera VII. Other productions will be Cherubini's "The Portuguese Inn" and Act I of Puccini's "La Boheme".

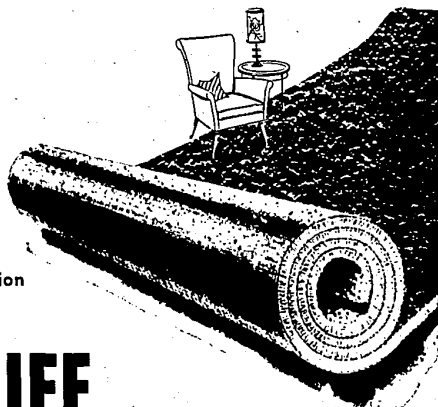

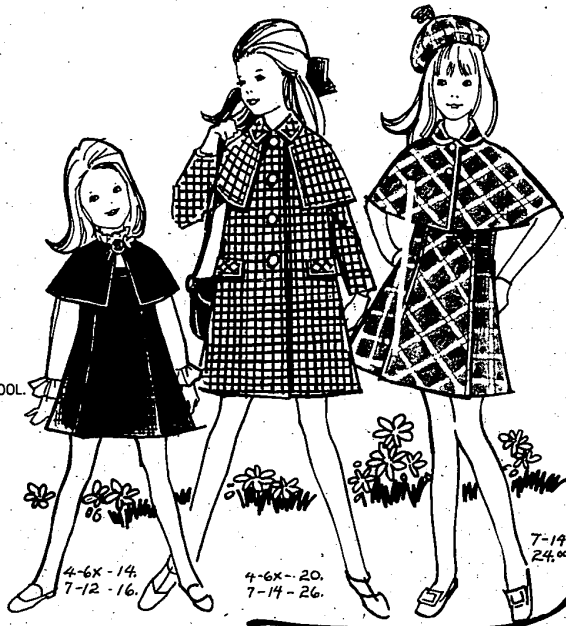
