

Sculpture Display Opens April 3

A rare opportunity to see 32 sculptures and 30 drawings by Henry Moore assembled in a single exhibition is presented by the Detroit Institute of Arts, Wednesday, April 3 through Sunday, April 28.

Generally acknowledged as Britain's greatest living artist and one of the most important sculptors of the 20th century, Moore is perhaps familiar to Detroiters through his massive elmwood "Reclining Figure" in the museum's Sculpture Court and by a small stone version of the same subject, both in the permanent collection.

All objects in the special Moore exhibition organized by the Smithsonian Institute have been loaned by the artist, his wife and daughter. They range in date from 1930 to 1964 and

"Robinson Crusoe," the final production in this season's Omnibus series of children's theatrical performances, will be presented Sunday, April 7, at 2 p.m. in the Aaron DeJoy Theatre of the Jewish Community Center of Detroit, 18100 Meyers Rd. at Curtis.

The famed Rockefeller Players of New York City will stage the drama.

The group is a repertory company of touring classics for children in straight dramatic form. Directed by Lucille Rockefeller, the players are well-trained professionals with all the skills of adult theatre.

Lucille Rockefeller has played on Broadway and toured with Frank Lea Short's Shakespearean company. She appeared on the Philco Hour and other TV dramas, directed the experimental Blue Moon Anchorage Theatre, and founded and directs the Children's Theatre Workshop in Teaneck, N.J.

Admission to "Robinson Crusoe" is 75 cents for Center members and \$1 for non-members.
