Ford Motor Company has launched its ninth annual Detroit-area Community Awards Program to honor employees and their spouses who participate in civic, educational and charitable activities.

A panel of prominent Michigan citizens will select individuals whose services are most outstanding for recognition at an awards dinner in June.

"The need for voluntary individual involvement in community affairs has taken on new significance in the last year," said Frank T. Judge, Jr., manager of the Ford Community Relations Department. "Our employees and their husbands or wives have made important contributions, and this program gives us an opportunity to recognize their efforts."

Nominations—open until the end of March—may be made by fellow employees, relatives, neighbors, community leaders or anyone else familiar with the nominee's community-service activities.

PERSONS JUDGED to have demonstrated unusual dedication and to have made the most outstanding civic contributions

receive "Citizen of the Year" Town Crier Bells—the company's highest service award.

Other successful nominees receive "Outstanding Service Awards"—mounted silver scrolls bearing engraved citations from Board Chairman Henry Ford II—or "Good Citizen Citations."

Last year 163 employees or their spouses received awards in the Detroit area, with nine persons cited as "Ford Citizens of the Year."

Ford began recognizing community service in 1959 with a program at Ypsilanti. By 1960 the practice was extended to other cities in which Ford has plants, offices or parts depots. Last year the program was conducted in 35 communities, with more than 2,000 individuals nominated.

Man Gets A Horse After Car Accident Costs His License

LANSING—Years ago when the auto was in its infancy and used to travel down the rule of dirt roads well-grooved by horse-drawn carts, the smart alecks used to yell, "Get a horse!" That's exactly what a rural Saline man did to get around.

Secretary of State James M. Hare said he received this story from James Rohrer, of Tecumseh. Rohrer, a driver license examining regional manager for seven counties, told Hare he was in his office when a man rode up on a horse in the shopping center which houses the Ann Arbor examining station.

"He parked his steed in one of the parking areas, tied him up, and came in for a license re-examination. It seems that he had been an uninsured driver, been involved in an accident, and was placed under financial responsibility.

"One of our enforcement officers had picked up his driver license and his auto license plates. Undaunted, he rode his horse some 12 or 13 miles for the re-exam."

"At least he was law abiding," Hare said. "He apparently took his suspension seriously."
