

Kadish Praises Johnson, Hails Peace Move

Paul Y. Kadish, chairman of the Livonia Democratic Party, today praised President Johnson for "courageously removing himself from the political arena in order to put the welfare of the nation above political ambition."

The statement is part of an effort to weld together the party factions split by the Vietnam war issue.

Following is the remainder of Kadish's statement:

"Personally, I believe that this was the only effective manner in which the United States, under the present administration, could have initiated steps to begin preliminary negotia-

tions in Vietnam. I am convinced that President Johnson was sincere in his announcement, as recent events prove."

"It has been obvious for some time that the position of the United States in Vietnam has

been completely untenable. The leading spokesman in this country for peace in Vietnam have been Senators Kennedy, McCarthy, Fulbright, Morse, General John Gavin and John Kenneth Galbraith. They, along with many others, have

foreseen the need to stop the bombing in order to make negotiations possible."

"Now that preliminary negotiations seem to be inevitable, it is hopeful that we will, within a relatively short period of time, be able to settle the dis-

pute in Vietnam."

"Once this has been accomplished, we in America will be able to take the necessary steps to solve some of the major problems at home. It is my hope that, if we are able to settle

the Vietnam war, the people of the United States, through their representatives in Congress, will see fit to provide the necessary funds to combat poverty and provide improved education, housing and employment for all."
