Montreal Exhibit Hosts Irish Tavern Fare

A little bit of heaven from Ireland across the sea will be seen this year at Montreal's "Man and His World" which opened as a permanent exposition May 17.

Ireland did not participate in the extravaganza last year when it was Expo 67 and would not be there this year either but for the fierce pride of two Canadian Irishmen and a Canadian Scotchman (yet).

While the Irish government was giving deep thought to the project, Kenneth J. McKenna, a florist, James Donaldson, an architect, and Kenneth Mackay, an attorney, all of Montreal, took it upon themselves to make numerous trips to Ireland where they solicited private funds for an Irish Pavilion.

Their financial combing of the Irish Country—side paid off handsomely, the needed money was raised, and an additional bonus came in the form of many Irish collectors who expressed the wish to act as hostesses at the Pavilion.

The three explorers then met with Montreal Mayor Jean Drapeau and final arrangements for Irish participation were completed.

The pavilion will be known as "Irish House"—"In a Maison d'Irlande"—"In a House of Ireland", and will be under the administration of a non-profit organization known as the Irish House Corporation. The Government of Ireland will collaborate with the organizers to the fullest extent.

According to McKenna, the pavilion will occupy the Pavilion of Economic Progress on the Notre Dame, one of two islands in the St. Lawrence River which was the site of last year's Expo. A striking feature of the new pavilion will be an authentic replica of Dublin's famous Abbey Tavern, a world-renowned establishment offering food—daily from Dublin—Irish dancers, Irish wit and Irish coffee.

McKenna said there will also be a showcase of the culture, history, arts, crafts and industry of the Emerald Isle, such as Irish lace, Waterford glass, Irish distillers' displays and even a memorial to Thomas D'Arcy McGee, the only member of the Canadian Government ever to be assassinated.

All but three of the 62 pavilions of Expo 67 will remain intact, and two additional nations—Ireland and Poland will exhibit for the first time.

Admission tickets called "visas", are being sold at banks, travel agencies, airline offices, transportation companies, and all offices of the American Express Company, exclusive general agents for "Man and His World" in the U.S.

Current History At U-D

"America in Our Generation," a history course covering the post-World War II era, will be offered in the University of Detroit summer session for the first time.

"Two timely circumstances this summer afford us an unusual opportunity to relate the immediate present to the immediate past," said Dr. Clifford Reutter, associate professor, who planned the course.

"All candidates and non-candidates for the presidential nomination are products of American life in our own generation, and the course extends to the very eye of the national conventions. We will relate the course to these men as they are exemplars or products of the history of our time."

UD Sets Radio-TV Institute

Registration is now open for the "Advanced Media Institute" at the University of Detroit. The institute will be offered in the summer session June 24 through July 26 under the direction of Rev. James A. Brown, S.J., chairman of radio-TV.

"This institute is intended for college teachers of various academic disciplines who wish to improve undergraduate instruction and who have already studied or had experience in educational TV program preparation," explained Fr. Brown.

"We will provide professional and technical facilities for systematic, guided training in advanced planning, preparation, production and critical appraisal of educational TV content for use in higher education, with emphasis on practical utilization of TV in undergraduate college courses."

The U.S. government has provided a grant which pays fees, a living stipend of \$75 a week plus \$15 for dependents with tuition waived.
