Direct home improvement loans are available from FIDA to cover this expense. This cost can be spread over a period of three-to-five years.
Cairns advises homeowners to take bids from several contractors and warns against accepting the first available offer.
FOR A FEW DOLLARS a month, homeowners involved can not only eliminate disease-ridden, sewage-filled ditches but increase the value of their property. And these few dollars may represent a much smaller expenditure than paying huge medical bills resulting from open sewage.
