

3 NFH Students Win Jaycee Music Contest

Three 15-year old pianists have been named winners in the sixth annual Farmington Jaycee Musical Scholarship Competition held recently in Farmington High School. For the first time, the undertaking was handled by members of the Jaycee Auxiliary.

Jerra Gorrell, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Lester Gorrell, 28243 Greenwood, Farmington, won the first place \$150 scholarship. Second and third place winners were Arlayne Olson, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Harold Olson, 30109 Westfield, Farmington, and Jeff Manuel, son of Mr. and Mrs. Homer Manuel, of Birmingham, a student at North Farmington High.

JERRA, who also attends North Farmington, played Beethoven's "Sonata Pathetique" in the competition. She must be accomplished to have won first place, but admitted to The Enterprise & Observer that she is casual about practicing during the school year.

"I practice a lot when I get a chance," she said, "and sometimes I don't." Jerra is thinking about a career in music, but what kind she hasn't yet decided. She has been accepted for the summer at Blue Lake Fine Arts Music Camp and plans to begin study of the harp. She has taken piano lessons for six years.

ARLAYNE, who will enter North Farmington High next fall, has studied cello for three years and piano for more than a year. She won second place in the Jaycee contest for her rendition of "Ballade" by Debussy and will study cello this summer on a scholarship at Michigan State University.

According to Arlayne, if a musician worries too much about her hands, "She might not even be able to wash the dishes." (Sad Thought). However, the talented miss does admit to wearing three pairs of gloves when she goes skiing.

THIRD PLACE WINNER Jeff has studied piano for seven years and played Chopin's "Fantasy Impromptu" in the competition. He has attended Interlochen Music camp, has played a number of concerts and is thinking about a concert career.

Although Jeff claims he likes rock and roll and classical music "equally well," his mother says, "He listens to rock and roll, but would never be caught 'PLAYING' it."

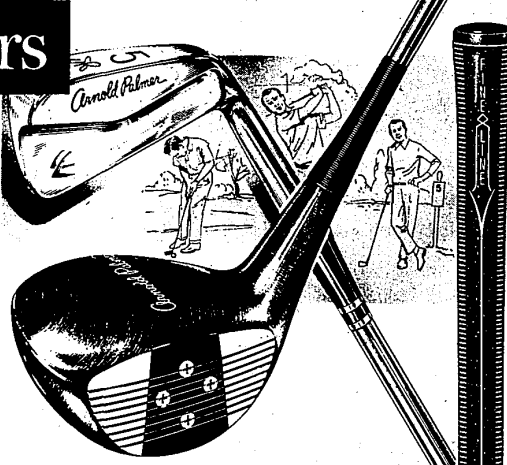
