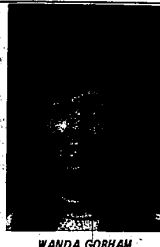

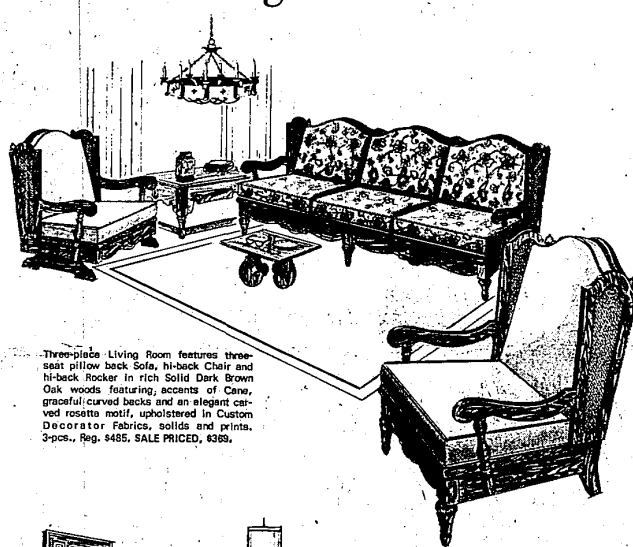
During July and August, the auxiliary will hold one meeting monthly, starting the second Wednesday in September.

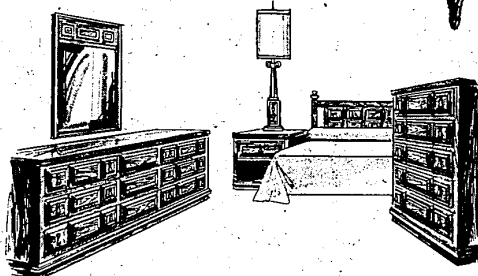

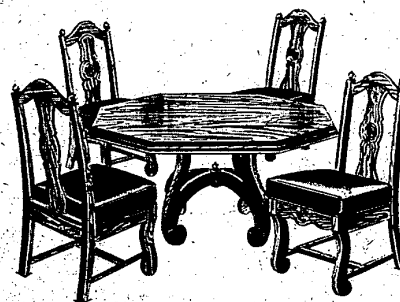
