Tax Is Rentor's Burden

WASHINGTON—For renters who live in the poorer neighborhoods of the big city the property tax is a healty regressive and very costly sales tax on housing.

In economic terms, the average equivalent of a 24 per cent sales tax acts to reduce severely consumer demand for

cent sales tax acts to reduce severely consumer demand for inner city housing. The cost of inferior rental housing is in-ordinately high. Investment in new buildings is discouraged and landlords are deterred from making, improvements in their naking improvements in their

property.

Low-income families pay a far higher fraction of their income for property taxes, either directly or hidden in their rent bills, than do typical suburban residents.

Former Illinois Sen, Paul H. Douglas, who is chairmand the commission, said he had not been fully aware how inequitable the property tax is in the practical application and social consequences.

The Douglas commission is expected to issue a report on zoning and land use problems. For many years the property tax has traditionally been the chief source of local govern-ment financing.

Although fax rates may be higher in some bedroom subras, Netzer said the propuly taxpayer in the central city pays for many more social welfare and other public sertices that do not directly benefit him. In fact, some of his taxes are for services that the suburban commuter shares.

IN MANY metropolitan area, moreover, the effective property tax rates are substantially higher in the central cities than in the surrounding suburbs. Assessment breaks for businesses in the suburbs have further encouraged the decentralization of economic activity from the central city outward, according to the New Yorkprocessor. To escape the heavy social service costs in the city, industries are moving with bright supply into the suburbs, Heavy health and welfare onlines plus the "legacy of obscience," are factors that Netzer said keep pushing property.

A family earning over \$15,-000 will pay less than half, measured as a percentage profies of total income, for property taxes, than a renter with an income in the \$5,000-34,000 range, Netzer's report pointed out.

NETZER SUGGESTED a umber of possible solutions the problem: less reliance on the property tax for urban public services, more state and federal activities, user charges for public services, local in-come taxes, and heavy taxes on land values and increases in land values.

"It is a generally inferior
tax instrument, although not
the worst of all possible taxes,"
he concluded.




