

Notice is hereby given that in conformity with the "Michigan Election Law", I, the undersigned Clerk, will upon any day, except Sunday and a legal holiday, the day of any regular or special election or primary election, receive for registration the name of any legal voter who may file a declaration of residence in the Township, City or Village where he resides, and who resides, who may APPLY TO ME PERSONALLY for such registration.

As provided by Section 494, Act No. 116,
Public Acts of 1954 As Amended.

For the purpose of REVIEWING the REGISTRATION
and REGISTERING such of the qualified electors in said
Township, City or Village as SHALL PROPERLY
apply thereto.

The name of no person but an ACTUAL RESIDENT
of the precinct at the time of registration, and entitled
under the Constitution, if remaining such resident, to vote
at the next election, shall be entered in the registration
book.

The township office will be open all day the Saturday
prior to close of registrations.

ELIGIBLE UNABLE TO MAKE PERSONAL APPLICATION, PROCEDURE

SEC. 504. Any elector who is unable to make personal application for registration because of physical disability or infirmity, or who is absent from his home or place of residence, or who is unable to go to the place of registration before any election or primary election by securing from the Clerk of the Township, City or Village, or from the Clerk of the County, a registration card and executing in duplicate the registration affidavit before a notary public or other officer legally authorized to administer oaths and returning such registration card to the Clerk of the Township, City or Village, as soon as practicable during the last day of registration prior to any election or primary election. The notary public or other officer administering the oath shall sign his name on the line for the signature of the registration officer and designate his title.

UNREGISTERED PERSONS NOT ENTITLED TO VOTE

SEC. 507. An inspector of elections for any election or primary election in a Township, City or Village, or in a Precinct of the same, shall not receive the vote of any person whose name is not registered in the registration book of the Township, Ward or Precinct in which he offers to vote, (As provided under Act 116, P.A. 1954.)

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION, APPLICATION, TIME

SEC. 508. An registered elector may upon change of residence, within the Township, City or Village cause his registration to be transferred to his new address by sending to the Clerk a signed request, stating his present address, the date he moved thereto, and the address from which he transferred. The Clerk shall strike through the last address, ward and precinct number on the original and duplicate registration card and record the new address, ward and precinct number on the original and duplicate registration card in proper precinct file. Such transfers shall not be made after the Fifth Friday next preceding any election or primary election, (unless such Friday shall fall on a Saturday, Sunday or Monday) and shall be accepted during the next full working day).

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION ON ELECTION DAY

SEC. 507. Any registered elector who has removed from one election precinct to another, or from a Township, City or Village to another, or from another Township, City or Village to a Township, City or Village, shall transfer his registration in accordance with the application. When the name of any street in a Township, City or Village has been changed, it shall be the duty of the Township, City or Village Clerk to make a change in the proper name of street in the registration records, and it shall not be necessary for the elector to change his registration with respect thereto in order to be eligible to vote.
