## Livonia, Plymouth Groups To Bus To Meadow Brook

The July 12 concert in the Meadow Brook Music Festival,

featuring Andre Kostelanetz as guest conductor, will attract two busloads of music lovers from the Observer area.

Groups from both Livonia and Plymouth will make the trip to the Oakland University campus for the concert under the stars that night.

Mrs. Barbara Core, head of the Meadow Brook committee in Livonia, said reservations should be made by July 5 and would be \$5.25 a couple, including bus ride and festival.

The Plymouth tour has full reservations.

The concert will begin at 8:30 p.m. Meadow Brook's fifth season, which opened Thursday, June 27, is its most ambitious program to date.

It includes 34 concerts in an eight-week season, featuring the full Detroit Symphony Orchestra and a large array of instrumental, vocal and ballet talent.

SOLOIST IN THE opening week is violinist Camilla Wicks, and others to come include Eugene List, Vladimir Ashkenazy, and Philippe Entremont, pianists; soprano Anna Moffo, violinist Edith Peinemann and cellist Anna Rose.

Each concert evening the Festival grounds will be opened two hours before concert time for picnics and buffet supper service.

## Know Needles When Weaving

In embroidery, just as in knitting, it's important to know your needles. When you work with a tightly woven fabric, the embroidery crewel needle is a good choice. This needle has a fine, sharp point.

For loosely woven fabrics, choose a tapestry needle which has a somewhat blunt point and a larger eye than the crewel needle. A rug needle is larger still and you'll want to use it when you embroider with extra thick yarns.

A fourth needle, called cheetle, is smaller than all the others and many needleworkers prefer its easy-to-handle size.

## Cut Stray Hairs

No matter how attractive a hair style is, its beauty can be lessened by stray hairs at the nape of the neck. This is a special problem when wearing shorter cuts and can be avoided by checking the back of your head in a three-way mirror. You discover stray hairs, use a comb to shape them into a miniature wave or smooth them into place and tape them using Dermacel tape. In addition it won't hurt coming off.

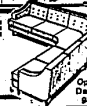

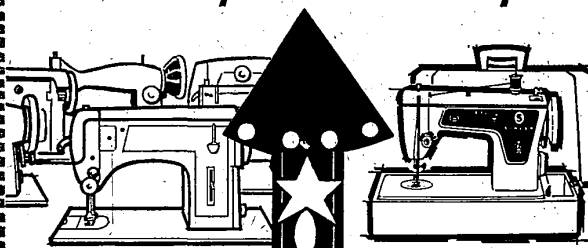
