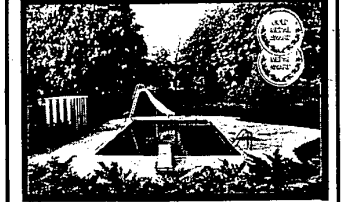


**Salow Joins Heeneey Staff**
