Jobs "Go Begging" MSC Official Says

Michigan State College's placement director has a weighty problem on his shoulders these days, but it's just the opposite of his perennial worry.

John Schlueter says he feels like Old Mother Hubbard with "so many good jobs I don't know what to do."

Schlueter says there is a critical need for graduates of engineering, chemistry, physics and related fields.

"At MSC we will be fortunate to fill one-fourth of these positions available between now and April," he added. Such technical jobs pay new graduates about \$275 to \$325 a month to start. The wage represents a 5 to 10 per cent increase over last year.

Schlueter attributes the situation to several factors, including complete absorption of 1950 college graduates by industry; heavy demand for technical graduates in military defense, and reluctance of draft eligible graduates to apply for jobs.

DECEMBER WORST MONTH FOR TRAFFIC SAFETY

December may be one of the worst months for traffic deaths in recent years unless the public and law enforcement officials work together to reduce 1950 year-end highway casualties, the Accident Prevention Department of the Association of Casualty and Surety Companies warns.

"December was the deadliest month on the highways during the past decade, with the exception of 1948 and 1942," declared Julien H. Harvey, the department's manager. "There is every reason to believe that unless motorists and pedestrians voluntarily exercise more caution than usual this coming month, and unless our law enforcement officers crack down on drinking drivers and flagrant violators of speed laws, December 1950 will exact an even worse toll than it usually does."

He warned that the following extra hazards have contributed greatly to December accident peaks and urged motorists and pedestrians to be on guard against them:

1. More drinking drivers, because of Christmas holiday festivities.
2. Bad weather, with icy roads usually prevalent in many sections.
3. Increased travel in hours of darkness for holiday shopping and trips home for Christmas.
4. More driver-fatigue and speeding among those making long drives home for the holidays.
5. Greater danger to pedestrians, especially in cities, due to Christmas shopping activity, particularly at night.

"Speeding and the use of alcoholic beverages are the primary cause of highway accidents," said Mr. Harvey. "A drink taken before driving can become a toast to death on the highway."

MSC Prexy Named To Land-Grant Post

John A. Hanah, president of Michigan State College, was reelected chairman of the executive committee of the Association of Land-Grant Colleges and Universities at its 64th annual meeting in Washington, D. C.

President Hanah, who will serve for one year, is the first officer in the association's history to be elected two consecutive terms. He served as president of the association in 1948-49.

Use A Frying Pan? Pork Chops May Be Braised In The Oven, Too

In a covered frying pan or in a casserole, versatile pork chops may be cooked either way. However, whether cooked on the range or in the oven, pork chops are prepared by the same method — by braising, according to home economist Reba Stagg.

And whether cooking chops over a sweet potato and apple combination casserole, apple dressing or over scalloped corn or potatoes, they are first browned slowly in a frying pan. Next, the chops are arranged over the casserole, the cover of the utensil closely fitted and the dish cooked in a 350 degree F. oven.

The correct top-of-the-range method is an identical procedure. When the chops are browned, the utensil is tightly covered so the chops can cook in moist heat for 45 minutes to 1 hour, depending upon their thickness.

As well as various cookery possibilities, there are various chops from which to choose. There are the popular center cut loin chops which many homemakers are sure to purchase. But according to Miss Stagg, for equally as flavorful a choice as the center chops, homemakers may choose rib chops or the shoulder arm and blade slices which are actually steaks. These are all prepared by the braising method and may be used interchangeably for range top or oven cooking.

FRUITED LOAF

Brighten winter meals with the famous combination of ham and pineapple. Sprinkle brown sugar over the bottom of a greased loaf pan covered with crushed pineapple. Top with a ground ham and pork loaf combination. When baked, turn the loaf upside down for tempting serving.

BRAISE OR STEW

Those cubes of meat usually prepared as a stew may be braised, too. Brown them thoroughly, then contrary to cooking as a stew, where the meat is completely covered with water, add only about 1/2 cup. Cover the pan tightly and let the cubes simmer until tender. Cubes of beef require from 2 1/2 to 3 hours cooking time. Veal and lamb require slightly less cooking time.
