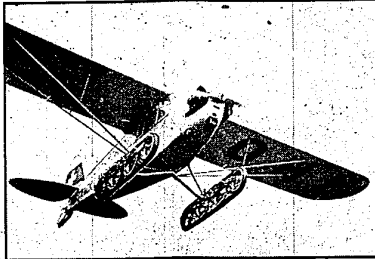

MSC To Launch Truckers' Course

A new program in truck driver training will be launched by Michigan State College this summer. Aimed at improved highway safety and efficiency for the trucking industry, the first course will be held July 2-20. Succeeding courses of two weeks duration will be held on a year-round basis.

One of two such programs in the nation, the plan is being developed by the MSC Continuing Education Service in cooperation with the Michigan Trucking Association. Graduates are expected to fill a demand for 1,200 new drivers needed by Michigan concerns during the next year.

An estimated 650 men will be trained annually in the classroom and "on the road," according to Leslie Silvernale, MSC coordinator of driver training. Trainees will work under driving experts and will use heavy equipment prepared specially for the program.

Classroom instruction will deal with such topics as state and federal codes, preventive maintenance, weight handling, basic driving fundamentals, inspection of equipment, driving in traffic, backing to loading docks and parking.

Power Company Warns Drivers

Summer thunderstorms like those of last week end are a reminder of the menace to motorists of electrical lines knocked down by wind or lightning.

R. P. Douglas, safety director for The Detroit Edison Company, believes the public is not fully aware of hazards that may exist in the short time before line-repair crews can be rushed to the scene of storm-grounded lines.

For example, he notes, a bus loaded with school children ran into a sheared-off high-voltage line near Wyandotte recently. The line was resting on the hood of the machine. Reports told how the passengers "fled safely out of the bus" before linemen arrived.

"The children should have been told to sit still," Douglas explains. "It was fortunate that this line was automatically de-energized by a circuit-breaker the moment it fell down. If it had been carrying current, children who tried to step down from the bus almost certainly would have been killed."

Douglas cites two simple rules that can save your life if for any reason a live wire touches the car you are occupying. "Here are the rules: (1) Sit tight. Tires act as insulators. Don't try to get out of the car unless it starts to burn. In case of fire...
