### FOR LAST SEASON SETS RECORD LOW

A record low of mink and skunks were bagged by hunters and trap-pers in the 1950-51 season, a con-servation department tally of re-port cards indicates. Nearly 18,000 mink were taken by

page 1.2.200 were uagged by 5,240 persons. Quantity of mink taken-appears to fluctuate directly with the number of hunters after them; judging from record comparison of previous years. Racoon hunters, while failing to do as well as before, cropped 3.8 animals each, trappers 2.8 animals each, 176,215 racoons were taken by 20,510 hunters and trappers as contrasted to 57,400 harvested by 14,260 persons: in 1945-50, About 55,900 racoons were taken in the southern lower peninsula. Skin prices generally were better for all three fur-bearing species, with racoons bringing as much as 100 per cent more in some cases.


