### LIT Fair Offers Fun May 5-7

The eighth annual spring fair of Lawrence Institute of Technology will be held Friday, May 5 through Sunday, May 7 on the campus at Northwestern and 10 Mile in Southfield.

The fair will open at 8 p.m. Friday and at noon on Saturday and Sunday. Closing time is midnight on all days. Admission is free. Parking is 50 cents.

David Schwartz, math senior who is chairman, said new rides and exhibits are scheduled, including helicopter rides.

Prizes this year will include a compact automobile, two color television sets, and a stereo.

Special entertainment is planned. Clowns will perform for the youngsters. A soccer match between the LIT Soccer Club and one from Wayne State University is scheduled on the campus at 1 p.m. Saturday.

Proceeds of the spring fair will go to the LIT library fund.

### Marygrove Registering For Summer

Summer school courses at Marygrove College begin June 26 through July and August. Registration is now open.

Courses in art, biology, business, education, history, English, French, German, Spanish, mathematics, music, the performing arts, philosophy, political science, psychology, religious studies and sociology will be offered through the day and evening.

Bachelor and associate degrees are granted at Marygrove.

### WSU Profs In Research

Two Observerland faculty members of Wayne State University have received research funds.

Assoc. Prof. Gordon F. Anderson of 28142 Muirland, Southfield, of the medical college, will research the comparison of several drugs which block the flow of an impulse from one nerve fiber to another in areas related to the urinary bladder. He will work under a \$1,500 grant from Marion Laboratories, Inc.

Prof. Edward C. Lim of 38578 Oak Pointe Drive, Farmington, of the chemistry department at WSU, will study isotope effects on certain molecules under a nearly \$40,000 contract from the U.S. Atomic Energy Commission.

### Nature Center Asks Classes

The nature center at Lower Huron Metropolitan Park near Belleville will open for 1972 school classes on Wednesdays and Thursdays beginning May 10.

Teachers may make advance appointments to bring their classes to the nature center to hear a lecture on natural science by naturalist William Davenport or to view exhibits. The trails are available for self-guided hikes.

Appointment hours are 10 a.m.; 10:45 a.m.; 11:30 a.m.; and 12:15 p.m. on Wednesdays and Thursdays. Groups are limited to one class at a time, and appointments should be made well in advance of the desired date.

To schedule appointments, teachers should call the nature center program of the Huron - Clinton Metropolitan Authority.

### Framing Safe

Lumber used for floor joists, roof rafters and wall studs and plates must be of size and grades required by building codes. Strength and stiffness of lumber is known from hundreds of laboratory tests -- and a wide margin over these is specified for added safety.
