

# Congress Districts Snarled By New Boundaries

The tremors from the new Congressional apportionment plan will be felt more in Observerland than anywhere else in the state.

The new plan was approved last week by U.S. District Judge Damon Keith after the State Legislature could not agree on a plan.

It may result in two local incumbents running against each other in the August primary and is also likely to produce a challenge to another incumbent by a local legislator.

The remaining Michigan Congressmen are protected by the plan. Currently the state has 12 Republican and seven Democratic U.S. Representatives though the Democrats make up a large portion of the state's voters.

**THIS PLAN** makes the Second Congressional District, now represented by U.S. Rep. Marvin Esch (R-Ann Arbor) a swing district and makes the 18th District, now headed by Republican Rep. William Broomfield of Loyal Oak, a largely Democratic district.

Broomfield is rumored to be considering moving to the 19th District to challenge incumbent U.S. Rep. Jack McDonald (R-Farmington).

**THE NEW FACE** of Observerland's Congressional districts look like this:

Esch's formerly Republican Second District lost Livingston and Lenawee Counties--both GOP strongholds--and moved eastward into Livonia, which is largely Democratic. Livonia is estimated to make up one-third of the population of the new Second District, adding a new liberal makeup to Esch's territory.

Esch, who is considered a moderate, may be challenged by State Rep. Marvin Stempien (D-Livonia) who is majority leader in the House.

Stempien has kept an eye on the district and helped author rejected Congressional plans that put Livonia in that district. The large student vote in Ann Arbor and Ypsilanti could work toward Stempien's favor.

Stempien was on vacation and could not be reached for comment on his possible candidacy Monday. Three other Democrats have announced for the August primary.

**THE NEW PLAN** took McDonald's 19th District almost completely out of Observerland by dropping Farmington City and Township, Livonia and Redford Township.

McDonald will keep most of his Oakland County portion of the district, including Democratic Pontiac, and will annex eastern Livingston County including the City of Brighton, and the townships of Brighton, Green Oak, Harland and Tryone.

The change in boundaries moved McDonald's Farmington residence into the 17th District, but he is expected to move his residence to Waterford Township in the center of his new district.

Broomfield's 18th District will move westward into Macomb County and lose all of Southfield.

U.S. Rep. Martha Griffith (D-Detroit) will pick up Southfield, Farmington, Farmington Township and Redford Township in her drastically changed 17th District.

Mrs. Griffiths, who was first elected to congress in 1964, represented Redford at one time and will be secure in the largely Democratic district. The least changed of the districts in the 18th District represented by Congressman William D. Ford (D-Westland). His district moves southward into Brownstown and Ash Townships but retains Westland, Wayne, Garden City and Canton Township and remains solidly Democratic.
