LIT Grads Will Hear Riccardo

John J. Riccardo, Chrysler Corp. president, will be the speaker and receive an honorary degree at Lawrence Institute of Technology's 40th annual commencement on Sunday, June 4 at 3 p.m. in the Ford Auditorium of Detroit's Civic Center.

Announcement was made by LIT President Wayne H. Buell, who will present a doctor of science degree in industrial management to Riccardo on behalf of the college board.

Riccardo will address 432 graduates and their families.

HE WAS elected president of Chrysler Corp. on Jan. 8, 1970 after serving three years as group vice president - U.S. and Canadian Automotive.

Riccardo joined Chrysler Corp. in 1959 as a financial staff executive on the international operations staff. Prior to joining the company, he was a manager in a public accounting firm.

In 1960, he was named general manager of the export-import division and then rose to top executive positions with Chrysler Canada, Dodge Car and Truck, and Chrysler - Plymouth divisions before becoming vice president marketing for the corporation in 1966, group vice president in 1967, and president in 1970.

BORN IN Little Falls, N.Y., Riccardo, 47, received bachelor and master's degrees from the University of Michigan where he was elected to Phi Beta Kappa. He is a certified public accountant.

He resides in Birmingham.

Woodlot Owners Get Course

Thousands of Michiganders own land that they use for recreational purposes and they are often interested in developing woodlots into worthwhile timber stands as well, according to Don Juchartz, director of the Wayne County office of the Michigan State University Cooperative Extension Service.

These absentee landowners are invited to an on-the-spot woodlot management demonstration to be held on Saturday, May 20, from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. at the woodlot at the Wayne County Child Development Center, on Sheldon Road just north of Five Mile Road, Northville.

The outdoor demonstration will cover: tree identification, marking trees for cutting, pruning, planning and herbicide use, thinning timber stands, and tapping maple trees for syrup production.

Forestry specialists from MSU will be on hand to assist local county agents in the demonstrations.

There is no charge for participation in this program. Woodlot management bulletins will be available for your use.
