Letters To The Editor

EDITOR:
Congratulations on your recent editorial concerning the ineptness of the plutocratic Farmington Township Board. Your analysis of the north-south controversy is a fair analysis which the Farmington Township Road and Civic Association also developed about four years ago but did not state so explicitly.

The idea that the more affluent, more conservative, and more populous north end of the township dominates its southern neighbors goes back many years to the time when Clarencville recognized its urban condition and attempted to do something about it. These citizens were, to a large extent, thwarted at every turn because political control resided with the rural farm community to the north and west.

The same situation exists today except the growers of corn have been replaced by dwellers in affluent suburban subdivisions; whereas the residents of the south end continue to be blue collar and less affluent as they were 40 years ago.

The attitudes of the affluent north-enders are much the same as they were then; since they control the majority political opinion they are determined to preserve their own status and community atmosphere as were their farmer counterparts in 1930. This is reflected in all actions of the township. The planning commission has two of its nine members living south of 10 Mile Rd. and one of these is a residential development proprietor hardy representative of other south end residents.

Further, there is essentially no undeveloped land (about half of the township area) which could be developed for low or medium income families because low housing density zoning requirements preclude the construction of low or medium income housing.

Another example is the tardy action of the township in even securing a master drainage plan let alone implementing it. Because of geological factors, and because the township drains to the south and east, the northern part of the township

does not have drainage problems. The township board almost a year ago authorized engineers to prepare a master drainage plan which has not been expedited but is in the hands of the engineers. Any implementation is still years away because the political control does not have pressing drainage problems.
