Cranbrook Science Unit Plans Summer Classes

BLOOMFIELD HILLS The world of nature, wooded trails, plants, animals, and rocks, awaits children at the Cranbrook Institute of Science summer workshops.

Both indoor and outdoor projects are scheduled in June for children in grades one through six.

WORKSHOPS MEET at the institute twice a week for sessions of 1½ hours. Reservations may be made by calling the institute, 520 Lane Pine Road. Fees for most classes are \$15.

"Adventures in Nature Study," for grades one and two, will include explorations along institute nature center

trails and simple indoor projects to arouse interest in plants and animals. Two sections are offered from 9 to 10:30 a.m., Mondays and Wednesdays, June 19 to July 12, and 9 to 10:30 a.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays, June 27 to July 13.

"Introduction to Nature Study," for grades three and four, will use nature center collections to illustrate and examine varied topics. Two sections meet on Mondays and Wednesdays, June 19 to July 12, from 9 to 10:30 a.m. and from 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

"SUMMER ROCK HOUNDS," for grades three and four, will include

short field trips to gather specimens, indoor projects on rock identification and how to start a home collection. This group will meet Mondays and Wednesdays, June 19 to July 13 (skipping the week of July 4), from 9 to 10:30 a.m.

"Nature Center Workshop" for grades five and six will devote each meeting to a specific topic in natural history and ecology. Nature center equipment and collections will illustrate key concepts explored. Two sessions are offered, from 9 to 10:30 a.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, June 20 to July 13, and 11 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., Tuesdays and Thursdays, June 20 to July 13.
