# YW Opens Summer Registration

Registration for summer program at Northwest Branch YWCA, 2540 Grand River, Redford Township, will open June 12.

The recreational and educational program to be offered will include activities for all age groups, scheduled for both daytimes and evenings. Of special interest is the expanded recreational program for boys and girls from six to 12 years of age. It will meet two days a week and alternate Fridays from 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., for an eight-week term beginning June 26.

Other youth programs will include ballet, tennis, swimming, sewing and two-week sessions at YWCA Camp Cavell near Lexington, Mich. A program for teens will include art, guitar, swim-

ming, sewing, tennis and driver's training. Adult men and women will be offered golf, yoga, bridge, Latin dance, ballroom dance, volleyball, interior design, aircraft ground school and drivers training.

Programs for women only will encompass physical fitness, adult ballet, stitch in knits and a special Ladies Day Camp on Wednesday mornings with a nursery for pre-schoolers. Swim classes and recreational swim periods will be available for all members of the family throughout the summer.

Early registration is advisable and further information may be obtained by calling the Northwest Branch. The branch serves Redford Township, Farmington, Southfield and Livonia. The YWCA is a torch drive agency.

## Day Camp To Have 2 Sessions

Anyone working with children in an outdoor setting may call the Southern Oakland Girl Scout Office, 1922 Catalpa Drive Royal Oak, to volunteer for day camp staff.

Day Camp Arapaho in Farmington will provide eight days of fun activities for 146 girls from June 19 to June 29.

A second session will take place July 10 to July 20 for an additional 139 girls.

Mrs. Edward Campbell and Mrs. Robert Bell of Farmington will direct the first session. Mrs. Robert Brooks of Novi and Mrs. Bernard Adams of Northville will direct the second.

The girls will sing, play games, explore the outdoors, build fires and cook with other girls their age.

"Westward Ho!" will be the theme. All girls will participate in choosing and planning their own programs so they can gain experience in decision making and leadership. Ecology will be stressed by recycling all materials used in camp.

## New School To Be Topic

Plans for establishment of an experimental school will be discussed at a meeting of interested citizens at 8 p.m., Wednesday, June 7, in the Universalist - Unitarian Church of Farmington, 25301 Halstead (north of Grand River).

The group will discuss the possibility of opening some time this year in a facility in the Farmington area.

Plans center around forming a school that is affirmative, child-centered and experimental in style and curriculum. It is hoped that the school will be racially and economically integrated as well.
