

Honor Dad With These Cookies

Called "padre" in Spanish, "pere" in French, "otets" in Russian and "otosan" in Japanese, Dad in different parts of the world has roles that differ even more than his many names.

In the United States, a new father struts around handing out cigars. But among the Ainu of Japan and in many African and South American tribes, the father takes to his bed right after the baby is born and stays there for periods ranging from a few days to a month! The mother, in contrast, returns to her housekeeping as soon as possible.

Why? Because it's believed that the newborn child is affected by whatever his father does. If he worked, hunted, chopped down trees or rowed during the first days of his life, the baby might be dangerously weakened by all that strenuous exercise! So Dad follows the safest course—and does nothing.

"Chasten they son while there is hope," advises the Bible, "and let not thy soul spare for his crying." But in the Arapesh tribe of New Guinea, one of Father's biggest jobs is to see that his offspring never cry.

Among these gentle folk, children are given almost anything they ask for, coddled and cuddled well past babyhood. Fathers as well as mothers delight in feeding the youngsters by hand, slipping them the choicest morsels of food. The kids grow up, not as spoiled brats, but as replicas of their mild parents.

Father's Day seems like a good incentive to fill up the cookie jar with peanut butter oatmeal snaps, try a fancy new chicken recipe and this frozen praline pie.

FROZEN PRALINE PIE

1 baked 9-inch pastry shell
 3/4 c. Karo light or dark corn syrup
 1 pkg. (8-ounce) cream cheese, softened
 1/4 c. margarine
 1/3 c. firmly packed light brown sugar
 3/4 c. milk
 3/4 c. coarsely chopped or broken pecans
 Whipped cream (optional)

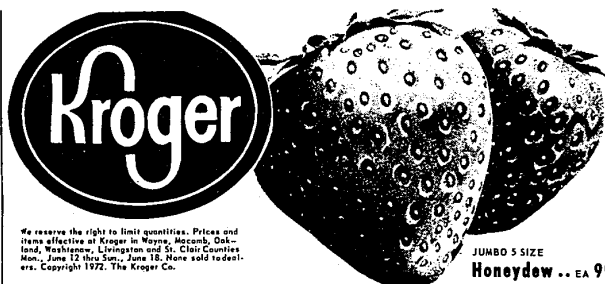
Gradually add the corn syrup to the cream cheese, stirring until smooth. Melt margarine and brown sugar over medium heat, stirring constantly. Gradually stir into the cream cheese mixture. Stir in milk. Pour into baked shell. Sprinkle pecans over top of pie and freeze until firm, four to six hours. Serve with whipped cream if desired.

CURRIED BREAD OF CHICKEN VERONIQUE

6 chicken breast halves
 Salt and paprika
 Flour
 1/2 c. butter or margarine
 1/2 c. flour
 1 can chicken broth (10 1/2 oz. condensed)
 1 c. light cream
 1 t. curry powder
 1 1/2 c. seedless green grapes
 Wash chicken and pat dry. Sprinkle chicken on both sides with salt and paprika. Dip into flour. Heat butter and brown chicken on all sides. Cook over low heat, turning occasionally, until chicken is tender. Cover chicken while it is cooking. Remove chicken to a platter and keep warm. Add flour to pan drippings and stir to loosen all drippings. Gradually add the chicken broth, light cream and curry powder. Cook over low heat, stirring, until the sauce thickens. Add grapes and heat briefly. Spoon sauce over chicken breasts. Makes six servings.

PEANUT BUTTER OATMEAL SNAPS

Mix together 1/4 cup peanut butter, 1/4 cup margarine, 1/2 cup granulated sugar, 1/2 cup firmly packed brown sugar. Mix in one beaten egg and 1/2 teaspoon vanilla then one cup quick oats, one cup sifted flour and 1/4 cup chopped nuts. Shape into a roll about two inches in diameter. Wrap in waxed paper and chill about four hours or until firm. Cut in 1/4 - inch slices with a sharp knife. Place on ungreased baking sheet. Bake at 350 degrees for eight to 10 minutes or until edges are slightly browned. Remove immediately from baking sheet and cool on wire rack. Makes about 36 cookies.
