

Try Recipe Shower For Bride

Having a bridal shower? Then shower the bride with recipes. Include a three by five-inch recipe card with each invitation and ask each guest to write down her favorite recipe as a gift for the guest of honor.

Frozen fruit cheese salad makes a delicious dessert for the bridal shower and serves equally well as your favorite recipe for the new bride.

- FROZEN FRUIT CHEESE SALAD**
- 2 c. sieved cottage cheese
 - 1 c. dairy sour cream
 - 3 T. confectioners sugar
 - 3/4 t. salt
 - 1 c. drained pineapple tidbits
 - 1 c. diced orange sections
 - 1 c. blueberries
 - 1 large banana, sliced
 - 1/2 c. sliced maraschino cherries
 - 1/2 c. chopped blanched almonds
- Blend together cheese, sour cream, sugar and salt. Fold in remaining ingredients. Pour into two refrigerator trays and freeze until firm. At serving time, cut salad into squares and top each serving with Creamy Pink Dressing made by blending two tablespoons maraschino cherry juice with one cup dairy sour cream.



SANDWICH TOWER

Trim the crusts from two loaves (one pound each) unsliced white bread and one loaf (one pound) unsliced whole wheat bread. Cut each loaf into five lengthwise slices. Spread generously with butter filling (see below) and reassemble, with dark and light slices in each loaf. Top with plain bread. Cut one loaf in half. Place the half next to a whole loaf as the bottom tier of the tower. Use whole loaf as the second tier, and the remaining half loaf as the top tier. Frost tower with thick swirls of cream cheese frosting (below). Decorate with stuffed green olives, cucumber slices, watercress and radishes. To serve, slice each tier separately. Makes 48 thin multi-layered sandwiches.

BASIC BUTTER FILLING
1 1/4 c. butter, softened
1/2 c. brandy or bourbon
Salt to taste

Blend well to make a smooth, light paste. Remove about one cup and reserve. Spread the remaining butter on six of the long bread slices. Cover three buttered slices with thinly sliced smoked salmon or ham; cover the other three with thinly sliced cucumber or water cress leaves.

CREAM CHEESE FROSTING
2 lb. cream cheese
1/2 c. milk

Blend cream cheese and milk and frost tower thickly.

TIPS FOR THE BRIDE
If you're a bride-to-be planning a new kitchen, here's a list of kitchen utensils you'll use almost every day:

A set of measuring spoons, a set of measuring cups for both dry and liquid measurements, set of mixing bowls, a flour sifter and strainer.

Don't forget knives for paring, slicing, utility and bread. Include a rotary beater, wooden spoon, ladle, tongs and a long-handled fork on your list.

A spatula, pancake turner, slotted spoon, and a potato masher will all come in handy. You'll need a chopping board, funnel, grater, colander, pastry brush, minute timer, potato peeler, can opener, bottle opener and corkscrew.

You'll also need saucapans with covers in one, two and three-quart sizes and baking dishes or covered casseroles in one and two-quart sizes. A double boiler, a heavy skillet or frying pan with a cover, a roasting pan with a rack, cake pans in round, square and tubular styles, pie pans, baking sheets, coffee-maker, salad mold and a toaster also will make meal preparation easier for the new homemaker.
