Red Cross Graduates And Babies Have Party

Graduates of the Red Cross mother and baby care classes introduced their new babies to course instructors at a reception held recently in the Red Cross west regional office in Dearborn.

"Usually, we meet with the parents every week for the six-week course, but we rarely get the opportunity to see the children and find out how the graduates are doing," Eulalie Maxim, RN, chairman of nursing and health programs, said.

"We are happy to say that the parents that joined us at the reception found Red Cross training to be quite helpful," she added.

While awaiting the baby's birth, expectant parents learn the importance of early and continuing medical care and how to diaper, bathe and feed the baby.

The class also familiarizes mothers and fathers with various stages of the baby's development during the first year. In addition, instructors explain the need to budget time and money. The responsibilities of parents to the community and how

The series will begin in Aldersgate United Methodist Church in Redford Township on July 24.

Registered nurses instruct the classes which meet at 7:30 one night a week for six weeks. Day sessions are scheduled whenever interest warrants.

The association advises beginning the classes at least eight weeks before a baby is due. The husband is urged to attend, although this is not necessary.

A new series begins approximately every seven weeks.
