City, Township, School Meetings Are Considered

FARMINGTON The Farmington school board thinks better communication with township and city officials may make its job easier and maybe save it a little money.

Aldo Vagnozzi, head of the board's one-man legislative committee, recommended quarterly meetings with "all government representatives in the school district."

Board members and administrators cited instances of communication and the lack of it.

There was the Youth Employment Service which was enthusiastically supported with supplies from the school district and money from the city but which was turned down by Farmington Township.

On the other hand there is the yearly supply of gasoline which was bid for jointly by the school district and the city last year "which saved the city a good deal of money but didn't do us much good," said business manager William C. Prisk.

Republican Treasurer Candidates Have Say

Thomas Nolan

Thomas Nolan, running for re-election as township treasurer, says "the office has never been in as good a shape."

He does not work at the job full time, he says, because he also has a full time job as sales manager for a trucking firm. "I said how I would run the office when I campaigned," he said during a recent interview.

"It's all up to date," he says now of the books of the township.

In a rare opportunity for a treasurer to innovate, he supervised the transition to a computer billing system for tax bills.

"It was a smooth transition," he said. "Unlike many cities and townships that did the same thing, no tax bills were late in Farmington."

A supporter of incorporation, he feels it is a necessary step to the efficient administration of the township.

Charles Foust

Charles Foust, a teacher in the Livonia School District, wants to see "unity among the members of the board and township hall."

Foust worked on incumbent Supervisor Earl Teeple's campaign, was later employed in the township zoning department for a summer.

"I want to make a full-time job out of it," he says of the treasurer's post.

Incumbent Thomas Nolan also holds a full-time job as sales manager for a trucking company, a job he announced he would keep while he was running for office during the last election.

But Foust also says he may not be able to immediately step in if elected, because of his contract with the schools.

He has asked for a leave of absence but doesn't expect it to be approved before February, which would mean he wouldn't be able to devote full time for a month or more. "We need a lot of unity, especially in transition to cityhood," he says. "To me it has come to the point where anything Teeple's wants is opposed by the rest of the board."

Foust is running as part of a "slate" along with Clerk trustee candidates Joseph Teeple and Steven Davidovich, supporting the incumbent supervisor.
