

# Detroit Symphony Sets Free Outdoor Concerts

Following the success of last year's free outdoor summer music theater concerts, the Detroit Symphony Orchestra has planned a second series of programs featuring excerpts from favorite operas and Broadway shows Aug. 24 to Sept. 3.

Concerts will be at Mercy College, Civic Center Plaza, Belle Isle and Rouge Park sponsored by the Detroit Dept. of Parks and Recreation.

Ten American singers will appear with the orchestra under the direction of Paul Freedman. Fred Bellinger, William Hall and Onta Sanders are all Detroit residents who sang in last summer's music theater. Also appearing will be Davis Gloff and Barbara Windham of Detroit and John Meyers of Pittsburgh. Making their symphony debuts will be Elizabeth Cole, Faye Robinson and tenor William Brown.

on Aug. 24 to 27 with excerpts from Verdi's "Rigoletto" and Bernstein's "Candide" and "West Side Story." It will be repeated Aug. 31 in Rouge Park in the winter sports area near Joy and Lahser.

The second program will feature excerpts from Pucini's "Madame Butterfly" and Rodgers and Hammerstein's "Carousel." "The Sound of Music." The performance will be at Belle Isle, on Aug. 29 it will be at Mercy College, and Sept. 2 at Outer Drive, Detroit, and on Sept. 1 at Rouge Park.

Excerpts from Verdi's "La Traviata," "Fiddler on the Roof" and "My Fair Lady" will be on the third program Aug. 26 at Belle Isle, Aug. 30 at Mercy College, and Sept. 2 at Rouge Park.

The final program will feature excerpts from "La

Traviata," "Candide," "West Side Story," and "The Sound of Music" on Sept. 3 in conjunction with the International Festival at the Civic Center Plaza at the foot of Woodward Ave. This performance is at 6 p.m.

All performances will begin at 8 p.m., except for the final program which is at 6 p.m. Each program will also include an overture and selections from other operas.
