## Fewer Coeds Try But More Chosen For Grad Studies

**ANN ARBOR** Men outnumber women two to one as applicants to the University of Michigan School of Graduate Studies this fall, but a higher proportion of women were accepted.

In the school's four divisions, five out of 10 male applicants have been offered admission compared to six out of 10 women, according to Dean Donald E. Stokes.

Women represent 10 per cent of all applicants to the school's physical sciences and engineering division; 24 per cent in biological and health sciences; 37 per cent in social sciences and education; and 52 per cent in humanities and arts. This averages 34 per cent in all divisions.

But women are consistently more successful in gaining admission, Dean Stokes says. In physical sciences and engineering, admission is offered to 70 per cent of the women applicants and 69 per cent of the men; in social sciences and education, 49 per cent of the women, 38 per cent of the men; in humanities and arts, 66 per cent of the women, 52 per cent of the men; in biological and health sciences,

62 per cent of the women and 49 per cent of the men.

Although the graduate school has not finished its studies of admission factors, Dean Stokes suspects that women applicants are better qualified than men. A more detailed analysis will compare male and female academic records and other credentials.

"Nonetheless, the pattern indicates that capable women have an excellent chance of admission in every division of the graduate school at Michigan," Dean Stokes says.

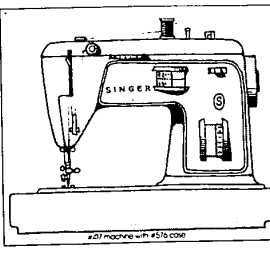
