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• Stock a selection of single-serving salads, desserts, and beverages in easy-open or flip-top cans -- they go from cupboard shelf to lunch box without wrapping. Choose from several flavors of puddings, gelatins, baked beans, bean or potato salads. A variety of fruit juices, juice drinks, and milk shakes are available to sip right from the container.

• Wrap lettuce and raw nibbles separately, first in wet paper towel, then in waxed paper, foil, or transparent wrap to keep them fresh and crisp. If juicy food is included, your lunch-box carrier will appreciate one of the wash-dry paper cloths that come in its own foil envelope.

• Copy the serving tray trick the airlines use and tuck in a neatly wrapped set of tableware (plastic knife, fork, and spoon), along with individual packets of mustard, catsup, jelly, sugar, salt, and pepper. Bundled together, these small items take little space, every-

thing is handy, and they avoid waste. You'll find these products in the picnic section of your supermarket or variety store.

• Make everything as easy to eat as possible. For example, before packing, cut a tomato into wedges, an orange in sections, or relishes into bite-sized pieces. This way, there won't be any utensils to juggle if meals are eaten on laps.

• Copy the tastes of refrigerator raiders and try hot foods cold as a change for sandwiches. Two suggestions: baked beans combined with diced luncheon meat or macaroni and cheese sparked with cubed ham.

• Balance meals with a sweet ending -- an eat-out-of-hand snack cake or pie or a small package of doughnuts or cookies that are available from supermarket bakery shelves. For children, add a surprise such as a small box of raisins, a bag of nuts, a candy bar, a small sack of potato or corn chips, or mixed presweetened cereals to munch on.

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
