

Musical Comedians Will Appear With Symphony

Return visits by two musical comedians, Victor Borge and Peter Schickele, are among the attractions recently announced for the Detroit Symphony Orchestra's coming season at Ford Auditorium.

New this season will be a special Christmas Festival "Pops" concert in December complementing the traditional performances of the "Messiah" and "The Nutcracker."

The "Pops" concert on Dec. 15 will feature conductor Sixten Ehrling and the Rachman Symphony Choir in a program of seasonal music including Robert Russell Bennett's "Many Moods of Christmas."

Borge will appear in the dual role of pianist and conductor at a gala fund raising concert on Jan. 20.

Schickele, the unscrupulous musicologist who entertained Detroiters with compositions of the fictitious P.D. Q. Bach, will appear March 25 at the pension-maintenance fund concert conducted by Pierre Hetsu.

The Young People's concert series opens Oct. 14 with performance for the

youngsters of Schumann's piano concerto by internationally acclaimed pianist Eugene Istomin.

The Detroit Severo Ballet Company and the Detroit Symphony Orchestra will present their annual performance of "The Nutcracker" on Dec. 9.

On Feb. 17, the orchestra will offer "Multi-Media Mix" featuring Merrill Ellis's "Mutations" and "An American in Paris" specially choreographed by a new dance group from the University of Michigan called "The Just Moving Company."

The series concludes on April 14 with appearances by the Helken Puppet Theater in Grieg's "Peer Gynt."

Conductor-in-residence Paul Freeman and associate conductor Hetsu will conduct two of the concerts.

Freeman will conduct the Orchestra in a program of "Music by George Gershwin" to open the Kresge Concerts, Oct. 8. The five Sunday matinee performances are at family prices.

This series continues on Dec. 17 with the annual performance of Handel's

"Messiah," featuring the Kenneth Jewell Chorale and the orchestra under Hetsu's direction.

"Music by Franz Liszt" will be featured Jan. 21 with James Tocco playing Second Piano Concerto and Ehrling conducting.

April 1 will feature an April Fool's Day concert, with the audience deciding by ballot what Ehrling and the orchestra will perform.

The final concert of the season is "An Afternoon of Ballet," with the Detroit Severo Ballet Company featured in Adolphe Adam's "Giselle" and a jazz ballet set to Copland's "Music for the Theater."

Seasons tickets are available at the Detroit Symphony Orchestra office in Ford Auditorium. The box office will open Sept. 18 for single ticket sales to all events.
