

Nursery Parents To Meet Sept. 5, 7

Orientation sessions for parents of nursery school children will begin Sept. 5 for the Wayne Cooperative Nursery, Inc. Classes will be held in Warrenwoods Wesleyan Church, 6615 Venoy, Westland.

The parents of the four-year-old morning group will meet Sept. 5 from 7 to 8 p.m. Parents of the afternoon group will meet from 8 to 10 the same evening.

PARENTS WHO have children in the three-year-old morning group will attend orientation sessions from 7:30 to 10 p.m., Sept. 7.

The nursery will open the week of Sept. 11 with one-half of each class present at each session. Mothers will be notified which day to bring their child. The first full sessions of nursery school will begin Sept. 18 for the four-year-olds and Sept. 19 for the younger children.

All mothers and fathers of children enrolled in the school are urged to attend the orientation sessions. The school is operated by a parents who take turns assisting the teacher. The

parents also have meetings the third Tuesday of each month and handle the organizational and business affairs of the school. Board meetings are held the second Monday.

AT THE GROUP'S last board meeting, Kathy Barker introduced new board members. They are Mrs. Cheryl Adair, field trip chairman; Mrs. Marge Parkins, "kid-bits" chairman; Mrs. Mary Golombiewski, first vice-president; and Mrs. Nancy Gray, third vice-president. All are from Westland.

Mrs. Edith Trudgeon, also of Westland, is the secretary. It was decided to purchase a nursery sign to be placed in front of the church. Mrs. Golombiewski, Mrs. Judy Houston and Dave Ramsden will work on this project.

Recycling Unit Won't Be Open

A new ice skating rink is causing the Redford Township recycling center some complications, and forcing it to shut down for the weekend. The recycling center is operated by volunteers on

land near the sanitation department, at 15200 Beech Daly. The land is being graded and black-topped for the new rink and will not be available for use for the recycling collections during this time. However regular hours will be resumed the weekend of Sept. 8-10.

The center will again be open from 3 to 5 p.m., Fridays, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturdays, and 2 to 5 p.m., Sundays, every weekend.

Operated as a community project, the center has been staffed by almost 1,000 young people and takes in between 20 and 25 tons of material each week.

It accepts newspapers tied in bundles or in grocery bags; cans that are cleaned, have the labels and lids removed and are flattened; and bottles and jars that are washed and have all metal removed.

All interested persons may bring these things to the recycling center...but not until Sept. 8.

Your family's general level of income will largely determine how much you can spend on a site. In some situations, you may have to delay the building of a home or cottage because of the initial cost of the building site.

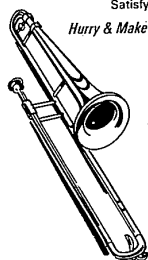
