The last set in the drama of Herman Rosenthal's death and Charles Becker's fight for life against the law, which demands his execution as penalty for the murder on July 16, 1912, opened in New York city May 6 with the beginning of Becker's second trial. District Attorney Whitman is prosecuting the case, while W. Bourke Cockran, one of the greatest lawyers and orators in the country, is the principal attorney for the defense. Both sides are confident.

# BRIEF FACTS IN THE MURDER CASE OF BECKER, WHOSE TRIAL BEGAN MAY 6
