The architects services are broken down into five phases:

- In the schematic design phase, he consults with the owner to ascertain 'the requirements of 'the project, prepares schematic design studies, and presents a Statement of Probable Construction Cost.
- In the design, development phase, he prepares design development documents
- In the Construction Documenta phase, he prepares the detailed

working drawings and specifications upon which the contractor's bids and the actual construction will be based.

- During the bidding or negotiation phase, he assists the owner in obtaining bids, negotiating proposals, and awarding and preparing construction contracts.
- Finally, in the construction phase, administration of the construction contract, he watches the work itself and issues Certificates for Payment as it progresses.
