Nursing Service Group Begins Fall Program

The letters PRN, in medical terminology, stand for the Latin phrase pro re nata which means "as needed."

The same letters stand for the Plymouth Registered Nurses Association, and the women in the organization that began in 1959 have a history of service "as needed."

The association will begin its fall season with a meeting at 8 p.m. Monday, Sept. 18, in the hospital auditorium of the Plymouth State Home, Five Mile and Sheldon.

Three years ago Mrs. Dale Coranite and Mrs. Roger Corey surveyed community health facilities and recommended to school officials a high school course to train nurses aides.

The accredited course now is offered both juniors and seniors, and two PRN members serve the high school vocational education department in an advisory capacity, assisting Mrs. Gharrity, a registered nurse.

ORIGINALLY organized to work with civil defense groups, the association in its first year set up classes in civil defense and worked out detailed plans for a disaster center for Plymouth schools.

In 1961, activities included a TB testing program and sponsorship of a medical self-help program.

When the community-wide polio immunization clinics were held in 1964, the nurses volunteered their services. In 1969 and 1970, the nursing association took over the vision testing program in the Plymouth school system, checking the vision of 3,000 children each year.

Group members also have assisted the Wayne County Health Department in the immunization of Plymouth children against rubella, or three-day measles.

LAST JANUARY the association joined the

Michigan Cancer foundation in sponsoring a pap test clinic, and 734 women took advantage of the service. PRN members also participated in Plymouth's Artrain and in the Health-O-Rama held in the Wayne County General Hospital in April.

The organization has donated funds for subscriptions of the American Journal of Nursing and RN magazine to both the Dunning-Hough and Schoolcraft College libraries for several years.

The PRN association, open to any registered nurse living in the Plymouth school district, holds meetings twice a month with speakers selected to keep the group updated in the medical field.
