

Bishop Loder Will Speak At Clarenceville

Bishop Dwight E. Loder will conduct a consecration service and preach in Clarenceville United Methodist Church at 10:30 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 17.

The church's new sanctuary and the Elsie Johns Chapel will be consecrated. The Rev. Elsie Johns, who has been pastor of the church since 1941, will assist in the service.

IN ADDITION to the sanctuary and chapel, new church offices have recently been completed. The church is located at 20500 Middle Belt, Livonia.

The new units cost \$400,000.

The church was first located

on Grand River and Collingwood Avenues in Detroit. After 25 years, members of the congregation purchased the Middle Belt Road site in 1958, and in 1966 built an educational unit at a cost of \$300,000. The unit was paid for in five years.


There will also be consecration services during the week of Sept. 17-22, including a homecoming banquet at 6:30 p.m., Friday, Sept. 22.
