

Bishop Loder Will Speak At Clarenceville

Bishop Dwight E. Loder will conduct a consecration service and preach in Clarenceville United Methodist Church at 10:30 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 17.

The church's new sanctuary and the Elsie Johns Chapel will be consecrated. The Rev. Elsie Johns, who has been pastor of the church since 1911, will assist in the service.

IN ADDITION to the sanctuary and chapel, new church offices have recently been completed. The church is located at 20300 Middle Belt, Livonia.

The new units cost \$400,000. The church was first located

on Grand River and Collingham Avenues in Detroit. After 25 years, members of the congregation purchased the Middle Belt Road site in 1958, and in 1966 built an educational unit at a cost of \$200,000. The unit was paid for in five years.

There will also be consecration services during the week of Sept. 17-22, including a home-coming banquet at 6:30 p.m., Friday, Sept. 22.

THE GUEST speaker will be Dr. John Marvin, editor of the Michigan Christian Advocate. He is \$2.50 for adults and \$1.25 for children.

On Tuesday evening, Sept.

19, at 7:30, the service will feature an explanation of the meaning of the windows in the new sanctuary by their designer, Douglas Phillips. Services will also be held at 7:30 p.m., Sept. 20 and 21. The first will be a victory prayer meeting and the second will be a musical presentation by Mrs. Paul Arensmann, minister of music.
