

Epiphany Sets Youth Service

Positive suggestions for good family relationships will be the theme of a panel discussion at 10 a.m., Sunday, Sept. 17, in Epiphany Lutheran Church, 4130 Five Mile Road, Plymouth.

The panel discussion will be part of a youth service in which young people will also act as liturgists, ushers and readers.

The young people will respond to a sermon preached several weeks ago by one of the laymen of the church about parent-child relationships. He pleaded for understanding on the part of the youth, emphasizing the fact that the parents' years of experience brought with it wisdom about life, and stressed the fact that children should listen to and obey their parents.

Ward Bible Class To Meet

The Community Bible Class taught by Mrs. Margaret Hess will hold its first fall session from 9:30 to 11 a.m., Tuesday, Sept. 19, in Ward United Presbyterian Church, Six Mile and Farmington Roads, Livonia.

This year's study will be Genesis to Deuteronomy and the subject of the first class will be "Modern Science and the Genesis Record." Mrs. Hess has just returned from studying the geological layers at Grand Canyon, Ariz., and she will discuss how these correspond with the Bible record of the beginnings of the earth.

STUDY MATERIALS covering two years of classes will be available for \$3. During the past year, women from 97 different churches and many denominations attended the class. Last year's meetings closed with a luncheon which 334 women attended.

Nurseries will be provided for infants, toddlers and preschoolers.

Mrs. Hess has taught Bible classes in the Chicago and Detroit areas for more than 25 years. At present she is also teaching a class in First Presbyterian Church of

Birmingham on Thursday mornings.

She is a popular guest speaker.
