Women Counselors Schedule Conference

Political and social aspects of academic counseling will be explored in the fall conference of the Michigan Association of Women Deans and Counselors in Weber Motor Inn, Ann Arbor, Oct. 20 to 21.

Barbara Geil, Schoolcraft College admissions director and MAWDC president, said women in the area interested in the subject may attend.

The organization's active members from the Observer area include Dorothy Bennett, counselor at Clarenceville High School and nominations committee chairman; Elizabeth Smith and Lucy Bodary, Churchill High counselors; Audrien Henry, Lowell Junior High counselor and immediate past president; Joanne Oxender, Franklin High counselor; Nancy Roleson, Garden City West counselor and Sylvia Vukmirovich, Schoolcraft College counselor and MAWDC newsletter editor.

Dr. Marjorie Lansing of Eastern Michigan University, who has done extensive research on the voting patterns of American women, will speak at the Friday evening session.

Life styles for women in a modern world will be the topic for the Saturday morning meeting. The speakers will be Janet Kahn and Linda Walker, University of Michigan graduate students who have designed a special freshmen women's orientation program.

Margaret Schilling, executive director of United Cerebral Palsy in Michigan, will speak Saturday afternoon and work with physically-handicapped girls in an educational setting.

The organization's purpose is to promote professional cooperation of women engaged in guidance and student personnel work, to encourage professional growth and to strengthen professional status.
