

Youth Symphony Picks 100 Members

Nearly 100 of the metropolitan area's most talented young musicians have been named members of the Detroit Symphony Youth Orchestra.

Plymouth this year has two members in the group. They are Margaret Lang and Libby Glover, string players.

Livonia is represented by seven young musicians, string players Melissa and Davin

Pierzon, and, in the brass section, Randy Evenden, Karen Nixon, Tony Bango, Paul Randall and Alger Labo. Westland will be represented in the brass section by Raymond Yager.

FARMINGTON is sending four to the symphony, Dirck Bondi and Marianne Walck in the strings; Mark Tetrault, in brass; and Ann Osterdale, woodwinds.

Southfield's Debbie Goally is in the string section.

The preliminary roster includes 51 new members and 43 returning players. Further auditions are scheduled for Oct. 21 and several more players will be added in the string section.

Persons interested in auditioning should call the symphony office in Ford Auditorium.

Under the baton of Paul

Freeman, the Youth Symphony will begin its concerts on Dec. 3 in Ford Auditorium.

THE GROUP will devote much of its time to rehearsals, meeting most Saturday afternoons for intensive work sessions with many members of the Detroit Symphony as well as some of its noted guest conductors.

Only a few major American orchestras sponsor a youth

orchestra. A milestone in the Detroit Symphony's two-year-old Detroit program was reached last month when Philip Austin, a bassoonist, member to join a professional symphony when he was appointed the first Youth Orchestra "graduate" to be named a member of the Symphony last year.
