

Falcons Throttle Southfield

Revenge was sweet and satisfying for the Farmington football squad.

There has been a growing rivalry between Southfield High and Farmington High and the Falcons took it in the blind side last year, losing in the last 20 seconds on a field goal, 9-7, with a fight erupting at the end.

THIS YEAR there was no SOUTHFIELD FUMBLE

away its opening kickoff advantage and Falcon Kevin Revere pounced on it on the Blue Jay 40. Jeff Krause spurted in for six points from the 10. Bob Drake's conversion failed and Farmington led after four minutes.

The Blue Jays notched it at six all on the following set of downs. Holton hit on a 24 yarder, the kick missed and it was tied. Farmington came back with

a 62 yard drive that overlapped one play in the second quarter, and that a 35 yard scoring loss from Rob Holton to Bill Cox. Brian Ratliff ran in a two-point play and the Falcons were up, 14-6. A 62 yard punt return by Falcon Shawn Hartle called back because of a clipping penalty but Farmington responded with a drive that netted 60 yards, highlighted by a Holton to Al Firek pass for 38 yards and six points.

FARMINGTON collected 10 first downs to Southfield's four and ground out 176 yards rushing and 76 in the air on three of four passes. Southfield mustered only 27 on three of 121 yards.

Now come the big ones for both Southfield and Farmington. The game that means the entire season for each, the game each school will have to live with for one complete year.

Farmington goes up against city rival North Farmington and Southfield tangles with city rival Southfield Lathrup. "We'll be able to give North a real battle this year," said Catherman. "The last four years haven't been much in the way of football but we are ready, more than we have ever been."

"We have won our last two and have allowed only two touchdowns in the last three games," added Catherman. "The defense is coming around, we are ready for it."

DRAKE MISSED on the conversion attempt and Farmington was still on the move, scoring one more touchdown to lead at the half, 26-6. Kevin Schafer recovered a Southfield fumble, and Brian Ratliff dashed in from 16 yards out. A pass for two missed and the Falcons were up by 20. The reserves took over for both squads in the final quarter and Dennis Detrich scored the final touchdown on a six yard romp around end.
