Arts Council Brings Experts To Classroom

FARMINGTON The Farmington Arts Council is beginning a new program in the area junior high schools to "bring art closer" to students, according to Arts Council President Mrs. Marlowe Bellanger.

The program will bring an expert on some phase of the arts into one of the junior high schools once a month, Mrs. Bellanger said.

The Suburban Ballet Company, a southeast Michigan group, and Ketzham Tazian, assistant professor of the arts at Oakland Community College, will be the first two programs at Power Junior High and Farmington Junior High.

"THIS IS the second project we have started to put in the schools," Mrs. Bellanger said. "Last month, we took some school people to the Detroit Institute of Arts to see their youth theater, and they will be bringing that out here in the elementary schools."

How Will Federal Funds Be Allocated?

How will the federal shared revenue sharing be distributed locally? The plan is to distribute Michigan's \$221.9 million one-third to the state and two-thirds to counties, cities, villages and townships.

This distribution, according to Farmington City Manager Robert Deadman, will be based on each county's population adjusted by the area's local tax effort and its relative per capita income compared to the whole state.

The local tax effort data first used to compute distribution has been found to be seriously out of date, Deadman said.

Allocations scheduled for October have been rescheduled for December, he added.
