College Credit Transfer OK'd

Graduates of local community colleges will be able to transfer to four-year colleges without losing general education credits under terms of a statewide agreement between community colleges and universities in Michigan.

Oakland Community College, Schoolcraft College and Wayne County Com-munity College were among the signers of the voluntary agreement Monday.

The 17 four-year colleges signing the agreement pledged to accept general education credits from community colleges, thereby eliminating possible loss of credits for transfer students. Fourteen community colleges signed the agreement.

Believed to be the first of its kind in the nation, the agreement climaxes five years of negotiations led by the Michigan Assn. of College Registrars and Admissions Officers

Registrars and Admissions Officers. The negotiations eliminated institutional differences in requirements in English composition, social science, natural science and

natural science and humanities courses. Most of the state's 38 four-year and 29 two-year colleges are expected to sign the agreement when they com-plete their studies of the un-precedented pact.




