

# Where It Is! '72-'73 Prep Cage Schedule

## GC West A Contender

The '72-'73 basketball story at Garden City West should be told in the early pages as Chris Babler begins his sixth season in the head coaching ranks.

West has won three titles and finished second twice under Babler in the Tri-River Conference. The Tigers are coming off an 11-6 season.

"Our key will be how much experience we can pick up early in the season," said Babler. "If the kids can find themselves and start to jell early, we will be all right, otherwise..."

West is sporting one returning starter in 6-5 junior forward Ken Kinsinger who averaged 11 points a game last season as a sophomore.

SENIORS make up the remaining front line for Babler.

Mark Kilbourn is a 6-4 captain who averaged five points per game and is followed by 5-11 Bob Carr, 6-3 Ted Richmond, and 5-10 Jim Smith.

The Tiger second team is composed of 6-0 junior guard Paul Tatrow, who averaged 14 points a game last season on

junior varsity; 6-3 Mike Carr who averaged 10 points on junior varsity; 6-3 junior Bob Radali and 6-4 sophomore Jay Gooch.

Babler sees Kennedy as the powerhouse in the Tri-River League with 12 of 13 back from last year. Schuler has four starters back and Southgate is sporting five returning let-temen.

"Southgate is the big horse of the league," said Babler. "There isn't a kid under 180 pounds on that team."

"In contrast, we are tall and slim. But we will be in there against Kennedy on Dec. 9."

The Tigers host Westland John Glenn Friday night (Dec. 1), play Ann Arbor Pioneer on Tuesday (Dec. 5) and open Tri-River competition at home against Kennedy on Dec. 9.

Southfield High has gone from small to smaller. Last year basketball bounced to a "small note" with the 9-9 Blue Jays averaging six feet-two inches in height. This was the smallest team Coach Don Kaump had ever had at Southfield.

Now in his sixth season as

head mentor, Kaump can again say this season will be his smallest ever.

Returning veterans on the '72-'73 roster will average only six feet.

"We are going to have to be one of the fastest teams around," said Kaump. "In addition to being small, we are very inexperienced."

THE SOUTHFIELD squad boasts only one senior. This is cross-country All-Stater Dan Henry, who didn't even play basketball last year.

The two returning letter winners are juniors Greg Miller and Dave Thowbridge who spent half of the season on junior varsity. The rest of the Southfield team will be composed of last year's junior varsity members who finished 13-3 overall and shared the Southeastern Michigan title.

Miller is a 5-10, 145 pound guard who played mainly junior varsity last season.

THROWBRIDGE is a 6-2, 178 pound forward who finished strong last season on varsity with an eight point average his sophomore season.

The rest of the Blue Jay '72-'73 composite features five juniors and one sophomore. Ira Labensky will be starting center at 6-2. The junior averaged 12 points last year on junior varsity.

JUNIOR DENNIS Fasbinder at 5-11 will hold the other guard slot with Miller.

WEST WILL again be in its 1-4 offense and will field probably its fastest team ever.

The Tigers host Westland John Glenn Friday night (Dec. 1), play Ann Arbor Pioneer on Tuesday (Dec. 5) and open Tri-River competition at home against Kennedy on Dec. 9.

Southfield opens with Suburban Eight for Redford Union Friday night (Dec. 1) at home, and encounters Catholic Central and Livonia Franklin before its league opener with Hazel Park on Dec. 15.

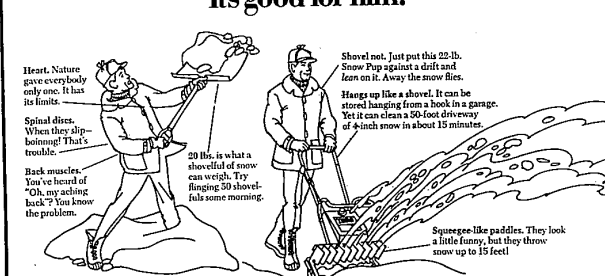
