Adding to the outing will be the expertise of Dr. Bill Forbes, professor of science from Oakland University, and Hartley Thornton, Proud Lake park naturalist.

Delevsky said, "We are hopeful these youngsters will learn more about their environment and become more aware of their individual roles in preserving and improving what presently exists. . . . Over the past year parents, teachers and students have participated in clean-up campaigns at Wooddale. Shrubs and trees also have been planted with the cooperation of the PTA and the youngsters."

LARRY FREEDMEN, assistant superintendent, said, "One of the major goals of all of the above activities is to make the Wooddale School site a laboratory for learning about man's natural environment. "What better place is there to start than at the school site itself?"

Foundation Is Established

EAST LANSING The Michigan State University Foundation, a major step toward attracting more private financial support to MSU, has been created by the board of trustees.

The new foundation will provide MSU's "overall development with significantly more flexibility," says Leslie W. Scott, vice president for development.

"It will allow us to accept and manage assets that are not generally available to the university itself," he said.

Although legally a separate entity, the foundation will serve MSU as its sole beneficiary. It will be able to accept such assets as land and trust funds, manage them, and turn them over to MSU for research and academic programs.
