Management Courses Beginning For Schools

PONTIAC Michigan State University, data processing; and pupil personnel. The computerized management systems already developed and under development at Oakland County Schools will be a part of academy course work. Local districts will be reimbursed from academy funds for the time their employees spend in the academy.

Plans for an academy to develop and upgrade the technological skills of persons employed by 28 school districts, including Farmington, were unveiled at the meeting of the Oakland County School Boards Association at Oakland Community College's Orchard Ridge campus in Farmington.

Oakland School Management Academy will begin limited operation March 15. It has the support of the Oakland County Association of School Superintendents and is initially funded with an \$82,000 allocation from the Board of Education of Oakland Schools.

IT WAS developed in response to requests from designated members of local boards of education for assistance in meeting demands for accountability in both curriculum and management areas.

Operation of the academy will be financed under provisions of the Vocational Education Act.

Courses for central office and building administrators as well as business office personnel will be conducted in the Southwest and Southeast Area Vocational Education Centers in Royal Oak and Walled Lake and at Oakland Schools in the County Service Center.
